Scenario


Shaun is the go-to person on his team for all things design. He is relied upon to create visually stunning Keynotes from scratch, and to ensure the team's presentations look professional and polished.

Scenario


Bi-weekly, Jessica presents the status of a priority project to senior leadership. These presentations are important for continued support and buy-in. Her team depends on her to represent their work.

Scenario



Goal

Tasks

- Writing short descriptions and annotations to explain the technical aspects of the project





- Feeling judged for the lack of visual polish of his slides, distracting from his focus on technical content
